





Additional Notes:

- Field Archeology (ANT 3120) is also required and is offered only in the summer. Recommended to take the summer after Junior Year. May take summer after sophomore year if prerequisite is met and the course has space.
- Required Geology courses have prerequisites. Students are advised to take GLY courses to meet their Science Inquiry to met these prerequisites.

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- Students may not enroll in a course as a CAPSTONE if they have already taken the parallel seminar course.
- Study abroad is strongly encouraged and the program of study outlined here can be adjusted to accommodate study abroad in any semester.
- Departmental Honors: any course may be contracted as an HONORS course if the instructor agrees and the course is suitable; HONORS research and thesis courses can fill the "open courses" at the Senior level.
- Foreign language is not required for the B.S., but is highly recommended for all anthropology majors.
- Minor is optional but quite feasible.
- Residency Requirements:
 - o 30 hours must be from ASU
 - o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
