Additional Notes:

The BA in Studio Art program of study is flexible as long as the prerequisites are followed.

The program is comprised of:

- Complete the 46 credit hours for the major
- Compete 18 credit hours at Appalachian State University
- Earn a minimum grade of C or 2.0 in each Art Course
- Fulfill the Junior Writing in the Discipline (WID) and the Senior Capstone Experience (CAP) requirements
- Complete 6 to 12 hours of a foreign language (LLC), and
- Complete a 12 to 24 credit hour minor in a discipline outside the visual arts

Students should check with the relevant department in which they wish to pursue their minor for the required number of hours. Commonly pursued minors by art history students include English, Women's Studies, General Business, History, Anthropology, and Philosophy.
