Additional Notes:

- <u>Residency Requirements:</u>
 - 31 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required for the degree).
 - o 21 hours in the major must be from ASU.
 - 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU.
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU).
- Adjustments to this four-year plan can be made based on transfer and AP credits.
- GRA 3900 should be taken as a Summer internship between the junior and senior years.
- GRA 4900 should be taken as a Summer internship after completion of senior year coursework.
