## **Additional Notes:**

- Minor outside of Art required for the major.
- No more than 46 hours in ART may be counted towards the degree (courses used for General Education credit, including ART 2030 and ART 2130, do not count toward the 46 hour limit).
- Students are encouraged to take the introductory courses as well as the two art history surveys early in their program.
- - Foreign Language requirements:
    - Six semester hours of a second year foreign language or higher, is required.
    - Students must take the Foreign Language Placement Test to determine starting course for the foreign language sequence.
    - If Foreign Language 1010 & 1020, or 1060 are taken for prerequisite purposes, the hours will count in place of six hours of free electives.



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## <u>Residency Requirements:</u>

- o 31 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required for the degree).
- o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
- 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU. (See the relevant department for the total number of hours required for the minor).
- Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU).
