Additional Notes:

- Required minor in Non-Profit Management.
- No more than 46 hours in a single discipline (ART or ARH) may be counted towards the degree (courses used for General Education credit, including ARH 2030, ARH 2130, and ART 2022, do not count toward the 46 hour limit).
- A maximum of 9 sh may double-count between Gen Ed and the major.
- Students are encouraged to take the introductory courses as well as the two art history surveys early in their program.
- The plan will enable students to complete the degree requirements in eight semesters and two consecutive term summer sessions.
- ART 4900 Internship (6 sh) to be completed after junior or senior year (CAP) during consecutive summer sessions 1 & 2.
- One 3000/4000 level Art History course must be focused on Non-Western Art.
- One 3000/4000 level Art History course must be a designated WID.

Foreign Language requirements:

- Six semester hours of a second year foreign language or higher, is required.
- Students must take the Foreign Language Placement Test to determine starting course for the foreign language sequence.
- If Foreign Language 1010 & 1020, or 1060 are taken for prerequisite purposes, the hours will count in place of six hours of free electives.

Residency Requirements:

- o 31 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required for the degree).
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
- o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU.
- O Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU).
