## **Additional Notes:**

- Apply for admission to teacher education in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester (Junior Year). Admission to teacher education is required before enrolling in Senior Block. Prior to Senior Year, request a graduation audit in the RCOE Deans Office, 404 COE Building.
- A student must have at least a 2.70 grade-point average to be admitted to the teacher education program and must maintain a 2.70 grade-point average overall through student teaching.
