- Students who wish to declare a major in Electronic Media/Broadcasting must [apply for admission](#) to the major.
- Residency Requirements:
  - 31 hours must be from ASU (25% of credit hours required in the degree).
  - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
  - 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU (if a minor is required).
  - Final 30 hours must be taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU).
