Residency Requirements:

- o 30 hours must be from ASU (25% of the credit hours required in the degree).
- 18 hours in the major must be from ASU.
- o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU (if minor is required).

Degree Requirements:

- INT 1001 are semester specific and must be taken sequentially in the freshman year. Students entering as sophomores may take the course in the summer prior to the fall semester of entry.
- Transfer students need to take a summer course sequence in order to be eligible for sophomore portfolio review in the spring of their first full year. (INT 1001, IND 1010, IND 2201)
- It is suggested that IND 2411 and IND 2120 should be taken in separate semesters.
- IND 2012 in the major may be used in General Education: Liberal Studies Experience. Fine Art Designation.
- ARH 2130 if taken for the major may be used in General Education: Liberal Studies Experience.
- MAT 1020 or higher fulfills the General Education: Quantitative Literacy.
