- There are enough Free Electives allowed in this degree to allow a minor. Students should speak to their advisors about possibilities.
- <u>Residency Requirements</u>:
 - o 31 hours must be from ASU
 - o 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - o 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - o Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
