- 18 s.h. in major and 9 s.h. in minor must be at ASU.
- 50 s.h. must be earned from a Senior Institution and 25% of the degree hours must be in residency at ASU, with the final 30 s.h. in residence.
- As stated in the catalog, the final responsibility for meeting graduation requirements remains with the student.
- Minimum Admission Requirements: 45 semester hours completed, minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0, Speech Proficiency Screening by the Communication Disorders Clinic, completion of prerequisite courses.
- Prerequisite Courses: RC 1000 (minimum grade of 3.0) or an equivalent course, RC 2001 (minimum grade of 3.0) or an equivalent course, four semester hours of the general education science inquiry perspective requirement (transfer equivalency accepted, including AP or University Placement), CSD 2259 and CSD 2260 (minimum grade of 3.0) or an equivalent course (transfer equivalency accepted for both).
