



- Admission to program is required. Visit http://nursing.appstate.edu/admissions for more information.
- 18 s.h. in major and 9 s.h. in minor must be at ASU.
- 50 s.h. must be earned from a Senior Institution and 25% of the degree hours must be in residency at ASU.
- An overall GPA of 2.50 is required in Nursing courses at the end of the junior year and every semester thereafter.
