- 18 s.h. in major and 9 s.h. in minor must be at ASU.
- 50 s.h. must be earned from a Senior Institution and 25% of the degree hours must be in residency at ASU, with the final 30 s.h. in residence.
- A overall GPA of 2.50 is required in Nursing courses at the end of the junior year and every semester thereafter.
- As stated in the catalog, the final responsibility for meeting graduation requirements remains with the student.
- NUR 3530, which is a Study Abroad course to Mexico, takes place over Spring Break. NUR 4530 is also offered as an elective NCLEX Preparation course for BSN seniors.
