 There are no GPA retention requirements. The Beaver College of Health Sciences requires a minimum 2.0 major GPA for graduation.
- R M CRTM grade requirements: All RM CRTM majors must earn a minimum grade of "C" (2.0) in the following courses: R M 2100, R M 3315, and R M 4210.
- A minor with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for this major.
- 18 s.h. in major and 9 s.h. in minor must be at ASU.
- 50 s.h. must be earned from a Senior Institution and 25% of the degree hours must be in residency at ASU.
- As stated in the catalog, the final responsibility for meeting graduation requirements remains with the student.
