- Foreign Language requirements:
  - $\circ$  ~ Six semester hours of a second year foreign language or higher, is required.
  - Students must take the Foreign Language Placement Test to determine starting course for the foreign language sequence.
  - If Foreign Language 1010 & 1020, or 1060 are taken for prerequisite purposes, the hours will count in place of six hours of free electives.
