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Additional Notes:

- Commercial Photography majors are required to submit a portfolio for review after completing or in the term of completion of the following courses: TEC 1022, TEC 2022, TEC 2032 and TEC 2052 (or course equivalencies as approved by the program coordinator, if a transfer student). Only students who have passed the portfolio review will be admitted into upper level (3000 and 4000 level) courses.
- Commercial Photography encourages students to consider taking TEC 3332 Field Experience NYC in their Junior and/or Senior year.
- Commercial Photography encourages students to consider summer study programs abroad. See advisor for trips organized by Commercial Photography Faculty
- Commercial Photography generally offers TEC 1022, 2113, 3312 and 3422 during the summer semesters.
